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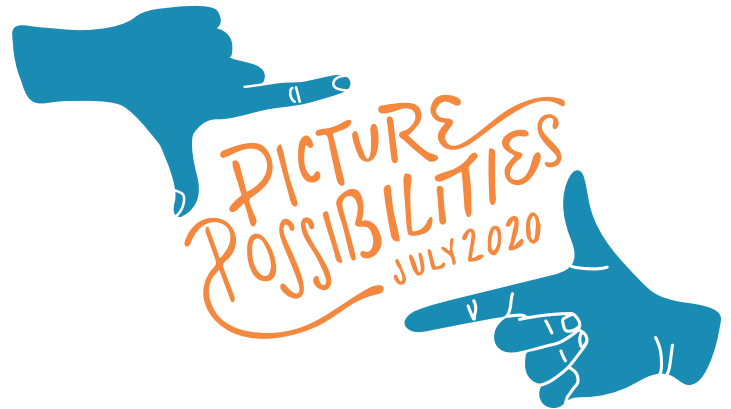
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# EVENT OVERVIEW

# HOW TO START YOUR FUNDRAISER

## CREATE A FUNDRAISING PAGE

1

- Go to **ADECINC.COM/PICTURE**
- Click on the “Fundraise for ADEC” button
- Follow the link to ADEC’s Picture Possibilities campaign page on justgiving.com
- Click the orange button that says, “start fundraising.”
- Follow the steps to customize your page or use ADEC’s default descriptions to get your fundraising page going!

## BUILD A CONTACT LIST

- These can be family, friends, coworkers, or other people you know
- Choose the best way to contact them. This can be by phone, email, in person, social media, etc.
- Check out our sample fundraising requests for ideas on what to say when asking for support
- Connect with your network and ask them to help meet your fundraising goal!

## COMPLETE A CHALLENGE

- Participate in ADEC’s weekly **Picture Possibilities** challenges
- Share a photo or video of your challenge on social media using #PicturePossibilities

# FUNDRAISING TIPS

## OWN YOUR STORY

The most effective story is your own. Your family and friends care about what you are passionate about, so share why you believe in ADEC and what ADEC means to you. Use your personal experiences and tell your story!

## ASK DIRECTLY AND PERSONALLY

Make direct asks from your friends and contacts. While general posts about your fundraiser will help spread the word, the most effective way to raise funds is to make the ask personal. Write a letter, make a phone call, or send a direct message to your friends. Don't be afraid to follow up: with busy schedules and full inboxes, it is it easy for people to miss your first outreach. If you would like help with this, make sure to contact our team at ADEC. We would love to help support you in your fundraising efforts!

## BE CONFIDENT

Be confident in your ask! You are supporting an important need in your community. You are giving people the opportunity to give their own friends and families with disabilities more choices and possibilities. Start with close family and friends first to build momentum for your fundraiser, then move to your broader friend network.

## BUILD A TEAM

Find other people to join up with you and set a goal together. Encourage your office to join you or get a group of friends who are passionate about ADEC too and fundraise together. It's always easier to hit your goal when you have friends to help you!

## SAY THANK YOU

Be sure to thank everyone who gives to your fundraiser. If you are having trouble coming up with language for a thank you, check out the sample "thank you" notes on pages 8-9.

# ADEC QUICK FACTS

- ADEC began in 1952 when a group of families decided that they wanted more for their children with disabilities than a life in an institution.
- ADEC now stands for “A life of their own, with Dignity, Employment, and Community.”
- In a standard year, ADEC serves over 1,300 individuals.
- ADEC has five day services located in Bristol, Elkhart, Goshen, Mishawaka, and Middlebury.
- ADEC’s transportation services travel a combined 600,000 miles a year.
- ADEC is the court appointed guardian of nearly 60 individuals.
- ADEC works around the clock by providing 24/7 support in residential spaces so that individuals receive the essential care that they need.
- Many of ADEC’s programs such as guardianship, transportation, family services and others are underfunded or not supported by the Medicaid waiver. This means that these programs rely on the support of people like you to continue as possibilities for the people ADEC serves.
- ADEC believes everyone has a right to informed choices and access to possibilities. That’s why it’s in our mission statement!
