WHO WE ARE



DAY SERVICES

ADEC's five Day Programs offer a community-based environment for adults with disabilities to spend their days doing what they enjoy while working towards personal goals. Offered Monday-Friday from 8am-2:30pm, day programs encourage creativity, goal-setting, community involvement, and dreaming big.



RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

ADEC offers supervised group living and supported living. Group living provides a group environment with around-the-clock care, while supportive living provides support as needed. Both services provide an opportunity to build independent living skills with personalized assistance.



COMMUNITY EMPLOYMENT

ADEC supports individuals with disabilities on their path toward meaningful employment by offering Employment Services and a Skills Training program. In addition, ADEC is a partner of Project SEARCH and a provider of Pre-Employment Transition Services in St. Joseph County.



CHILD & FAMILY SERVICES

ADEC works alongside parents to provide simple guidance or direct services for a child diagnosed with a disability. Our child and family services include a full-length Summer Camp Program, Therapy Services, and an After-School Program.



THERAPY SERVICES

ADEC offers Behavior Management, Recreational Therapies, and Music Therapies to children and adults in St. Joseph and Elkhart Counties. These services are provided to the community and ADEC programs by ADEC's Behavioral Consultants and Certified Therapists. All support plans are supervised by a Health Service Provider in Psychology.



GUARDIANSHIP

The 18th birthday is an important milestone that may mark the first time an individual can legally make their own decisions. ADEC's guardianship program is a resource for adults who may need guidance or assistance with personal decisions, advocating, and protection.

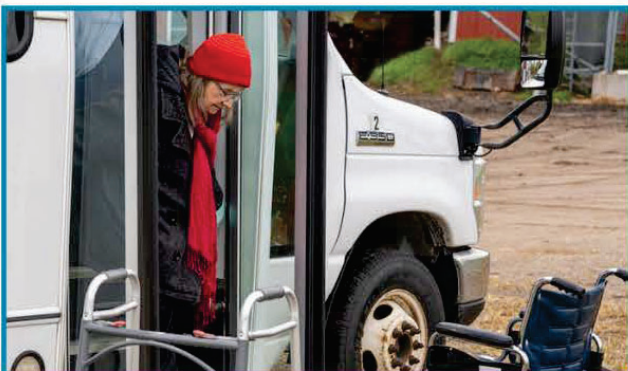


TRANSPORTATION
