- Protect from abuse, neglect, and exploitation
- Other responsibilities as needed

SUPERVISED GROUP LIVING

At each of ADEC's 14 group homes, residents work on building independent living skills with around-the-clock care. A group home provides skill-building opportunities, life-long friendships and bonds, and a safe space to establish a life of their own. Residences can be found in neighborhoods all throughout Elkhart County and into St. Joseph County.

SUPPORTED LIVING

ADEC's supported living program offers adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities an opportunity to hold independence in their daily lives. Each person's care is tailored to their needs and goals. The greatest goal of this program is to assist everyone in realizing their dreams through informed choice. Staff provide support in areas like financial management, nutrition, transportation, or coordination of medical care.
